Our participants come from all across India, and there have even been some who have crossed international borders to be with us.

We are extremely proud of the fact that many of our ex-participants are now successful doctors, engineers, lawyers, architects, film stars, models, teachers, the list is endless. But we are even prouder that they keep returning, to give back to the Programme that gave so much to them.

- 1.To expose you to a choice of careers, thus enhancing your prospects and your knowledge.
